Kerry thanked Board Members and Appointed Members for their timely input to the Annual Report. He stated that it was posted on the marac.org website for all to review

W4SIG thanked those who took the time to nominate their fellow members, the nominees for their county hunting efforts, members for voting, the Election Coordinator (KF7ZN), and Awards Committee and Awards Secretary (N5MLP). Congratulations to all!
6. Appointed position reports as needed Awards Manager, Awards Secretary, Historian, RoadRunner Editor, IT Director, Election Coordinator, Publicity and Advertising Coordinator,
Most of these appointed positions published their yearly reports in the 2022 Annual Report. Paige, W0FLZ, being newly appointed to the new position of Publicity and Advertising Coordinator spoke on her efforts and plans. She has created new MARAC window decals and sent samples to Board members. More will be on hand for distribution at the MARAC National

in October. She is pursuing an “ad exchange” between MARAC and other ham organizations in order to publicize MARAC and county hunting. Paige is sending MARAC info sheets to other ham clubs and organizations for publishing in their organizations. She is also starting up a new County Hunting Facebook page. More details will follow.

7. Openings for MARAC Secretary, General Counsel, Contest Chairman-W4SIG

Old Business:

8. Multiple family members receiving ballots via Simply Voting update

Discussion: NA8W

Darl stated that he and the Election Coordinator have been working with Simply Voting to ensure that multiple members of the same family receive ballots in a timely manner. So far, efforts have resulted in a correction of a prior issue. They will continue to monitor.

9. Discussion of possible awards price increases due to increase production costs-W0FLZ

Paige highlighted prior discussions among the Awards Secretary and the Board regarding the escalation of costs to process and ship MARAC awards. Board has deemed that, unfortunately, a price increase is eminent. The Board is working on coming up with the new prices.

10. Discussion of marac.org website updating- Logger II element – NF0N

Mike states that he is working with K3IMC on a timetable when the website element regarding Logger can be updated. This will be the first section of the website that will be changed. A overall refresh of the website is being worked on.

11. Discussion of placing pictures of available MARAC awards on website – NF0N

It was discussed that the Board would like pictures of the various MARAC awards to be available for viewing on the club’s website. N5MLP has pictures of about 20 of the available awards. He will work with AB7RW, NF0N and KA9JAC to identify the pictures missing from this effort and implement these images on the website.

12. Discussion of need for volunteer to assist K3IMC with development and support of Logger II

NF0N restated that K3IMC is in of need of Logger II development assistance. Qualified individuals are encouraged to contact NF0N for discussion of details. Our club does not want to in the bind of only having one individual with the knowledge to develop Logger II and continue its upkeep. It was noted that the 10-10 club just had this serious problem hit their club when their awards software developer became a SK. Don needs help!

13. Discussion of need to restart MRC bureau – KC5QCB

In an effort to assist newer county hunters in their pursuit of USACA and then MARAC awards, the Board has been discussing the possibility of reinitiating the MRC Bureau. While the quantity of MRCs that would probably be processed would be considerably less than it was a decade ago, the value still exists for those who incur the ever-rising costs of postage that accompany county contact verification. KC5QCB is going to contact the latest prior MRC Bureau manager, AF3X, for input. Janet has volunteered to run a new MRC bureau if the Board deems it necessary.

15. Nomination of Outstanding Service Award for Mike Delke, K8EMS- W4SIG

Mike has spent thousands of hours coding an working so that we can all have access to MARAC award tracking software that we can utilize and enjoy!
