Mike has always been an active mobile, both on SSB and CW, operating on multiple bands. From his home station, he always puts out a great signal on all bands and is a frequent mobile assistant by providing relays very often for the weaker signals. As far as his service to MARAC, Mike has been a District Director for the last 8 years and is always a valuable member of the Board. Mike also is a big part of MARAC's booth presence at the Dayton Hamvention each year. His continued activity and service to the club, along with his activity on the air justifies Mike, NF0N, for CHOTY.
